4. 2016 Emergency Management Proposed Budget

Patty Francour, IS Department Manager, described the creation of a diverse redundant network for Emergency Management that is included in the 2016 EM Budget. This is a fiber network that will extend from the Sheriff's Building to the Courthouse which is for network back-up purposes. This project, costing approximately \$19,000, is 50% reimbursed through the Emergency Management Planning Grant.

Linda gave an overview of the proposed 2016 EM Budget. Questions and answers followed.

5. WICAMS

Wisconsin Credentialing and Asset Management System (WICAMS) is an I.D. system for first responders to gain access to emergency sites after a disaster occurs. Emergency Management, Sheriff's Office and Public Health are the first agencies that will be implementing this I.D. system in Winnebago County.
