Saturday summer outdoor siren testing is complete for 2014 and will begin again April 2015. One new siren is planned for next year and that will be the site on Washington Avenue in Oshkosh (replacing old federal signal siren).

8. EPCRA Report

The EPCRA Planner, Bernie S., reported that he is about to begin the 2015 facility updates with one new plan at Eggers Industries in Neenah. That brings the total to 100 planning facilities in Winnebago County.
