4. Siren Report

The project of narrow-banding sirens in Winnebago County is complete. However, a few radio issues are still being worked out and the new repeater is also in the process of some fine tuning.

Winnebago County Ham Radio Operators are traveling to siren sites during the Saturday noon test verifying rotation and sound of each siren. They have identified a few issues that do not read out on the paper report that is run each Monday morning so Linda K. is very grateful to their organization for the assistance.

5. Training and Exercising

- Linda and Bernie were evaluators at a Public Health Ice Storm Exercise that was held in March.
- In 2014 Winnebago County was selected to host a SIMCOM Exercise (an exercise that focuses on communication testing between local and state agencies).
- Bernie gave a presentation on WHOPRS (Wisconsin Hazmat on-line Planning & Reporting System) to several other counties.
- Bernie gave a presentation to the Oshkosh Safety Council on the subject of severe weather safety planning.

 Emergency Management held a "Severe Weather Tabletop" exercise (5/22) focusing on safety at Titan Stadium. In attendance were participants from the Oshkosh School District, UWO, Lourdes Academy, Sheriff's Office, Oshkosh Police Dept. and Oshkosh Fire Dept. A second tabletop exercise with this same group discussing more in-depth issues is scheduled for September.
