- 1. Call to Order: P. O'Brien called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.
- 2. <u>Approve Agenda:</u> Motion to approve the August 21, 2013 agenda, made by K. Robl and seconded by J. Finch. Motion carried 6-0.
- 3. Public Comments on Agenda Items: None.
- 4. <u>Announcement/Communications:</u> P. Brennand announced that the Winnebago County Board received two more damage claims from Kreilkamp, bringing the total to five claims in the past six months.
- 5. <u>Approval of Minutes August 7, 2013 Open and Closed Session:</u> Motion to approve the August 7, 2013 open and closed session minutes made by J. Finch and seconded by G. Konrad. Motion carried 6-0.
- 6. <u>Discussion 2014 Budget Document Distribution:</u> J. Rabe distributed final documents for the 2014 budget packets to the Solid Waste Management Board (SWMB). Changes to the Mission

Statement, 2013 Accomplishments and 2014 Goals & Objectives were made as discussed at the August 7, 2013 SWMB meeting. Finance required changes to SSR Amortization and Payroll line items. The changes made by Finance also affected the 2014 Highlights section. By keeping the \$2/ton increase in solid waste tipping fees and making no change to single stream recycling tipping fees the 2014 Budget now yields a (\$306,796) deficit. J. Rabe and K. Pernsteiner will meet with the County Executive & Finance Director at 9:00 a.m. on August 23, 2013.

Discussion ensued amongst the SWMB members.

- 7. <u>Discussion NEWCMG/WCSWMA Fall Conference 2013</u>: J. Rabe distributed itinerary/registration forms on the upcoming NEWCMG/WCSWMA Fall Conference 2013 to the SWMB. The conference is scheduled for October 2-3, 2013 in Waupaca. Registration and room reservations are due by September 20, 2013. Completed registration forms should be submitted to Kathy Hutter. Keep in mind the conference dates conflict with a regular SWMB meeting on October 2, 2013.
- 8. <u>Discussion/Action Final Cover Construction Project Update:</u> J. Rabe presented the Final Cover Construction Project Update to the SWMB as follows:
  - Construction is progressing well as weather has been cooperating.
  - 2' compacted clay is complete
  - Geomembrane installation continues estimate 2-3 days remain.
  - Geocomposite installation continues estimate 5-6 days remain.
  - 2.5' rooting zone placement continues along with gas system piping/abandonments.
  - Surface water management features, topsoil placement and access road construction remain.
  - Three pay requests have been processed to date = \$1.932 million (total project \$4.165 million); pay request #4 to be submitted later this week.

Net contract reduction of ~\$60,300 is possible. Contract times remain at September 20, 2013 for substantial completion and September 27, 2013 for final completion.

9. <u>Discussion – Landfill Gas Operation Update:</u> J. Rabe updated the SWMB on the landfill gas operations as follows:

- J. Rabe updated the SWMB on WPS revenues, site odors and projects as follows:
- Odors still remain as a result of the final cover construction project; should be much improved once project is complete at the end of September 2013.
- WPS Revenues \$280,494 in July 2013 (on pace for \$3 million for 2013)
- p-BACT still in discussions with Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR); requesting no additional equipment for our site (increased preventative maintenance only)
- Siloxane Removal System June 2013 sample shows siloxanes levels are dropping but hydrogen sulfide levels are increasing; further discussions with vendors yield additional equipment required for hydrogen sulfide removal which increases payback time; continue evaluating equipment options/costs before "Go/No Go" decision is made.
- Gas Migration at Snell Road 5.2% methane reading in gas probe GMB-13 required WDNR notification; further data collection yields migration in south portion of site (same general area as 2001); need to increase vacuums in this part of site and are considering options.

Discussion ensued amongst the SWMB members.
