Scott Nelson- Bridge work continuing on CTH-Y and CTH-GG overheads.
The week of the July 14th incident management meeting for the 41 project scheduled

Chris Honish- Increase volume of calls regarding reckless driving/speeding resulted in increased patrol on 41, numerous contacts made during enforcement. Also mentioned Country USA injuries resulting from vehicle versus pedestrians (questioned future sidewalks?)

Mike Panosh- Local media event held in Winnebago County on Snell Road County Park ("Carp Pond's") called "Rutter Hit's the Water", educating boater's on drinking while boating. Panosh emphasized what a great turnout. Traffic fatalities from 2014 are down from 2013 (217 in 2014 from 234 in 2013).
Motorcycle fatalities are even with 2013 so far.

Christie- Winnebago County fatalities are about even from last year, (8 in 2013 to 7 so far in 2014).
Discussed Country USA impact on local/County/State roads in the area of CUSA grounds.

Daunita Kline- Questioned local law enforcement regarding proper bicycle location while riding on the roadway. Bike position while following a car making a right hand turn at a intersection. Christie responded, Bike should be behind the vehicle, not next to vehicle making the right turn motion.

Bob Doemel- CTH-I and CTH-N intersection and CTH-T re-construction update: Crews battling wet weather, construction stopped during upcoming EAA week. Thanked the State Patrol for working with the Hwy. Dept. on solving weight problems with county vehicles on 41.
