COUNTY BOARD CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Chairman Ramos provided an update for the vacancies in Districts 8, 16 and 21. Chairman Ramos has interviewed some of the applicants for Districts 8 and 21. He will meet with the other applicants for those districts after budget. The new supervisors will be announced and appointed at the November 16, 2021 county board meeting. District 16 has been posted in the Oshkosh Northwestern and Oshkosh Herald. Applications are due to the County Clerk's office by November 12, 2021.

Chairman Ramos reported on the budget process for this year. The amendment process will be the same as 2020. Vicky Fitzgerald, Winnebago County Finance Director, explained how the amendments will be handled. Amendments have to be turned in to the Finance Department by 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 3rd, for review. The amendments will be reviewed by Corporation Counsel and forwarded to the County Clerk's office. The County Clerk's office will post the amendments to the County's website and e-mail all County Board Supervisors by 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 3, 2021. The meeting will start at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday afternoon to vote on amendments and the budget for 2022.

COUNTY EXECUTIVE'S BUDGET PRESENTATION

Executive Doemel thanked everyone for the support that he and his family received for the passing of his father. Executive Doemel thanked his budget team: Vicky Fitzgerald - Finance Director; Doug Petraszak - Assistant Finance Director; Carol Blackmore - Budget Manager; Mike Collard – Human Resources Director; and Patti Francour – Information Systems Director. They helped to make his first budget a great learning experience.

Executive Doemel stated that this budget does not use the allowable net new construction factor to increase the tax levy. The increase of 1.15% would result in an increase of taxes by \$680,000.00. With this proposed budget, the tax rate would be \$4.61 per \$1,000 assessed value for Winnebago County. This would be \$.34 lower than 2021. This is the lowest tax levy in 35 years. He feels that a strategic planning process to assess programs utilized in the County was and will be used in putting budgets together.

Executive Doemel began his presentation of each department's budget.

He will be discussing his findings with Vice-Chairman Egan and the new Supervisor for those districts should be announced at the November 16, 2021 county board meeting. Chairman Ramos explained the process for this meeting. Departmental budgets have been reviewed. In the amendment stage, it is in the hands of the County Board. There are fifteen amendments for this budget. Each amendment will be voted on and the final vote will be to pass the budget.

COUNTY EXECUTIVE REPORT

Executive Doemel thanked everyone involved with his first budget session, the Finance Department, the Budget team and the Department heads and Elected Officials.

Executive Doemel did not include the net new construction value in this budget. With the elimination of some positions, the lower levy from Human Services, new revenues from the State, and some use of fund balance, these items reduced the levy. This does not mean that the taxes will be lower. If the county board choses to use the net new construction, that is up to them.

Executive Doemel commented on the need for staffing for his office.

Executive Doemel feels there is a need to have solid and open policy discussions in the future.
