2 **RESOLUTION: Reauthorization of the Winnebago county Self-Funded Workers'**
3 **Compensation Insurance Program**

5 **TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

6 **WHEREAS**, Winnebago County is a qualified political subdivision of the State of Wisconsin; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act ("Act") provides that employers covered by the Act
8 either insure their liability with workers' compensation insurance carriers authorized to do business in the State of
9 Wisconsin, or be exempted (self-insured) from insuring liabilities with a carrier and, thereby, assuming the
10 responsibility for its own worker's compensation risk and payment; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the State of Wisconsin and its political subdivisions may self-insure workers' compensation
12 without a special order from the Department of Workforce Development ("Department") if they agree to faithfully
13 report all compensable injuries and agree to comply with the Act and rules of the Department; and

14 **WHEREAS**, at its December 6, 2012, meeting, the Personnel and Finance Committee approved the
15 continuation of the self-insured workers' compensation program in compliance with Wis Admin Code DWD 80.60(3).

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors as follows:

17 (1) That the self-insured workers' compensation program that is currently in effect be continued.

18 (2) That the Winnebago County Clerk forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Workers'
19 Compensation Division of the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development.
