2 **RESOLUTION: Reauthorization of the Winnebago County Self-Funded Workers' Compensation**
3 **Insurance Program**

5 TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

6 **WHEREAS**, Winnebago County is a qualified political subdivision of the State of Wisconsin; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act (Act) provides that employers covered by the Act
8 either insure their liability with worker's compensation insurance carriers authorized to do business in the State of
9 Wisconsin or be exempted (self-insured) from insuring liabilities with a carrier and thereby assume the responsibility
0 for their own worker's compensation risk and payment; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the State of Wisconsin and its political subdivisions may self-insure worker's compensation
2 without a special order from the Department of Workforce Development (Department) if they agree to report faithfully
3 all compensable injuries and agree to comply with the Act and rules of the Department; and

4 **WHEREAS**, at its April 5, 2012, meeting the Personnel and Finance Committee approved the continuation of
5 the self-insured worker's compensation program in compliance with Chapter DWD 80.60(3) of the Wisconsin
6 Administrative Code.

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby
8 authorizes the following:

1. That the self-insured worker's compensation program that is currently in effect be continued.
2. That the Winnebago County Clerk forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Worker's Compensation Division of the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development.
