JOB DESCRIPTION

DEPARTMENT: Highway

POSITION: Mechanic/Parts Foreman

POSITION PURPOSE: Supervises and, at times, performs mechanical operations in the shop,

assists in ordering and maintaining inventory of parts and supplies, and

assists the shop superintendent as needed.

MAJOR DUTIES:

1. Supervises the operation of equipment and employees regarding equipment repair and service in the shop.

- 2. Makes out records and reports.
- 3. Maintains a current inventory of all parts and supplies with in the shop area and the County garage.
- 4. Prepares the purchase order for all supplies and parts as needed for the repair and maintenance of county vehicles and equipment.
- 5. Prepares work schedules for the mechanics and assigns work as necessary.
- 6. Performs mechanical repairs and maintenance on vehicles when the workload requires it.
- 7. Performs other related duties as assigned.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Ability to supervise and maintain effective working relationships with fellow employees.
- 2. Ability to organize equipment and employees for routine maintenance and specialized mechanical repairs.
- 3. Thorough knowledge of methods, practices, and materials needed for mechanical repair of the various county vehicles and equipment.
- 4. Ability to make records and reports, and work with computers.
- 5. Ability to maintain and generate information regarding inventory of parts and supplies.
- 6. Knowledge of mechanical parts and supplies and the ability to deal with vendors.
- 7. Ability to understand and carry out instructions.
- 8. High school diploma or its equivalency plus related experience preferred.
- 9. Possession of a valid driver's license.

PHYSICAL QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Ability to work in exposure to extreme in temperature and inclement weather when required.
- 2. Ability to perform strenuous or heavy manual labor.
- 3. Ability to work in tight spaces and an uncomfortable posture when required.
