1 170-52015 Request Sheriff to Read Declaration of Independence on Courthouse **RESOLUTION:** 2 Steps on July 4, 2015 3 4 TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS: 5 6 WHEREAS, the Continental Congress, by a Declaration of Independence, dated July 4, 1776, clearly 7 declared the inhabitants of New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Connecticut, New York, New Jersey, 8 Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Georgia, were no longer colonial 9 subjects to be exploited arbitrarily by servants of the King and Parliament of Great Britain, but now were free citizens 10 of their own territories, and that free citizens should constitute the governments for those territories; and 11 WHEREAS, the Continental Congress provided that same day, by orders of their House, that their 12 Declaration should be proclaimed aloud and published to the free citizens of the territories represented in their 13 Congress: and 14 WHEREAS, the notification of the Declaration to responsible citizens was then done by sheriffs who 15 proclaimed it at the courthouse steps, by clergymen who read it from their pulpits, and by printers who printed it in 16 their gazettes; and 17 WHEREAS, the Continental Congress thus initiated a process that has created the Constitutions and state 18 governments of our Union including the Constitution and government of the State of Wisconsin. 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby 20 21 requests Sheriff John Matz to read the Declaration of Independence from the steps of the Courthouse at 8:00 a.m. on 22 the morning of July 4, 2015, as this was the custom in the early history of our country. 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that we ask Sheriff Matz to 25 read the document without further comment or speech.
