3 **RESOLUTION: Request Sheriff to Read Declaration**
4 **of Independence on Courthouse**
5 **Steps on July 4, 2011**

7 **TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**
8

9 **WHEREAS**, the Continental Congress, by a Declaration of Independence, dated July 4,
10 1776, clearly declared the inhabitants of New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Rhode Island,
11 Connecticut, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina,
12 South Carolina and Georgia, were no longer colonial subjects to be exploited arbitrarily by
13 servants of the King and Parliament of Great Britain, but now were free citizens of their own
14 territories, and that free citizens should constitute the governments for those territories; and
15

16 **WHEREAS**, the Continental Congress provided that same day, by orders of their House,
17 that their Declaration should be proclaimed aloud and published to the free citizens of the
18 territories represented in their Congress; and
19

20 **WHEREAS**, the notification of the Declaration to responsible citizens was then done by
21 sheriffs, who proclaimed it at the courthouse steps, by clergymen, who read it from their pulpits,
22 and by printers, who printed it in their gazettes; and
23

24 **WHEREAS**, the Continental Congress thus initiated a process that has created the
25 Constitutions and state governments of our Union including the Constitution and government of
26 the State of Wisconsin.

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors
29 that it hereby requests Sheriff John Matz to read the Declaration of Independence from the steps
30 of the Courthouse at 8:00 a.m. on the morning of July 4, 2011, as this was the custom in the early
31 history of our country.

33 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that we
34 ask Sheriff Matz to read the document without further comment or speech. This event is intended
35 for those present to hear the words of the Declaration as we begin to celebrate our Day of
36 Independence.
