7	TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:
8	WHEREAS, the excessive amount of snowfall during the winter of 2013/2014, and the addition of a parking
9	lot due to the purchase of the Engineering Building, has caused UW Fox Valley to exceed Winnebago County's
10	share of its snow plowing budget; and
11	WHEREAS, the amount of the overage, which was created between the months of January 1, 2014 through
12	April 30, 2014, was \$27,276; and
13	WHEREAS, the projected amount for the months of October 2014, November 2014, and December 2014 is
14	\$22,724; and
15	WHEREAS, a review of past history indicates that the amount to be budgeted for the period between
16	October 1, 2014, and December 31, 2014, is a reasonable estimate.
17 18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby
19	appropriates \$50,000 to the UW Fox Valley's 2014 Budget's Snow Removal Accounts.
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that \$25,000 of the \$50,000
21	expense shall be transferred from the General Contingency Fund.
22	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that this Resolution is
23	contingent upon Outagamie County's approving their share of the additional expense.
24	Fiscal Note: The General Contingency Fund has a balance of \$300,000 prior to this transfer. The transfer will
25	reduce the balance by \$25,000.
