Minutes

Forsgren moved to approve the minutes as printed from the meeting held on August 4, 2011. Deanna Bradley gave a Second. The minutes were approved with a voice vote.

Chair, Thiel, read the agenda.

Public Hearing for Changing Parcels from A-1 to A-2 Zoning

Public Hearing for requests for a zoning change from A-1 to A-2 for the parcels in the Town of Utica listed on "Attachment A" of the September 1, 2011 Plan Commission Agenda.

Public Session:

A map of the Town of Utica was displayed showing the Farmland Preservation parcels as green, the parcels that were being requested to be changed from A-1 to A-2 as brown, and the parcels left white had no changes. It was also explained that a few of the "brown parcels" already had A-2 zoning in the Town of Utica, but there was a discrepancy with what the County had listed for "Town Zoning".

Attorney Sorenson answered questions that were asked that clarified the difference between Farmland Preservation credits and Farmland Tax Relief. Taxes are based on use. There is no correlation between Fair Market Value and Agricultural Use Valuation.

Public Session was closed.

Regular Session:

A Plan Commission member asked Attorney Sorenson if the four Plan Commission members who also have requested that parcels be rezoned from A-1 to A-2 could participate in the discussion and vote. He stated that they could. There was a discussion as to whether there were advantages to having land zoned A-2.

Gallert made a motion to recommend to the Town Board to change the zoning from

A-1 to A-2 for parcels listed on "Attachment A" of the Agenda for the September 1, 2011 Town of Utica Plan Commission meeting. Forsgren gave a Second.

Discussion: There was no discussion, but a check was made to be sure all Plan

Commission members had a copy of "Attachment A".

Vote: Yes-Deanna Bradley, Donavon Bradley, Forsgren, Gallert, Groth, Sweet, Thiel

No---None

Motion passed with a unanimous vote. (7-0)

Wesley and Sue Kranz Property

Review and discuss the site plan and Conditional Use for Wesley and Sue Kranz, 6371 County Road N, Pickett, WI 54964.

Wes distributed a site plan for only his property to each Plan Commission member. He had previously submitted a site plan along with a Conditional Use Application when the Public Hearing was held, but that site plan included a portion of his neighbor's land. Wes explained how he plans to move his fences and gardens back from the lot line. Vegetables are grown in the raised gardens for the Community Share Program and about half of the gardens are co-op gardens. He currently has 28 horses, 1 cow, 2 goats, and 1 sheep on his Special Needs Ranch. Therapeutic programs for handicapped children are conducted on the property. Wes informed the group that he no longer lives on the property. He currently lives in Oshkosh, but someone is there almost 24/7 to care for the animals.

Discussion: The Kranz parcel is zoned Rural Recreational and Residential Mixed Use. That zoning requires a principal residence. Now that there is no single family residence and the use has changed since the Conditional Use Application was submitted, a Conditional Use Permit can't be granted according to the Town of Utica Ordinance.

Kranz will have to reestablish a residence or consider other options available for the property without a residence.

Groth made a motion to deny the original Conditional Use Application. Sweet gave a Second.

Discussion: There was no discussion.

Vote: Yes--Deanna Bradley, Forsgren, Gallert, Groth, Sweet, Thiel

No-Donavon Bradley

Motion passed. (6-1)

<u>Informal Opinions:</u> There were no requests for Informal Opinions.

Topics, Issues, and/or Ideas for Future Meetings/Workshops

- Residential Farm Homestead overlay district
- Farmland Preservation Ordinance-Has to be completed by December, 2012.
- Formalized review or audit for Conditional Uses-It was suggested instead of a review or audit, as each Conditional Use is granted it should be kept on the agenda until all conditions have been met. Then, only reviewed on a complaint basis.

Wind Energy-There is little interest currently because of the standards.

Extraterritorial jurisdiction area for the City of Oshkosh-If someone wants to build in that area, remind them that they need to consult with the City Planner to find out the requirements.

Thiel made a motion to adjourn. Groth gave a Second. Motion passed with a voice vote.

Meeting adjourned at 8:46 p.m.


