

Key Points:

- Monkeypox does not spread easily to others, and the risk of monkeypox spreading widely throughout our community remains low.
- Getting <u>vaccinated</u> (if eligible), asking your healthcare provider <u>to test you</u> if you have <u>a rash</u> consistent with monkeypox, and <u>isolating</u> if infected continue to be important tools in reducing spread of the virus.
- Winnebago County Health Department is currently offering the JYNNEOS monkeypox vaccine, by appointment only, to individuals at the highest risk of infection based on the <u>Wisconsin</u> <u>Department of Health Services</u> prioritization.
