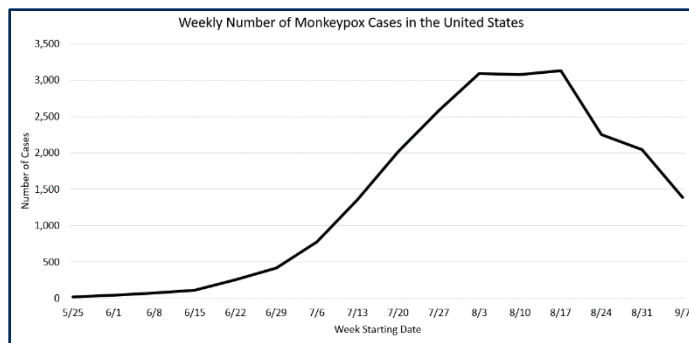

Key Points:

- Monkeypox does not spread easily to others, and the risk of monkeypox spreading widely throughout our community remains low.
- How to reduce spread of monkeypox:
 - Get [vaccinated](#) (if eligible).
 - Ask your healthcare provider [to test you](#) if you have [a rash](#) consistent with monkeypox.
 - [Isolate](#) if infected.
- Winnebago County Health Department is currently offering the JYNNEOS monkeypox vaccine, by appointment only, to individuals at the highest risk of infection based on the [Wisconsin Department of Health Services](#) prioritization.
