

- Get vaccinated. Staying up to date on your COVID-19 vaccines is the best thing you can do, no matter the community level.


Current Community Level Metrics for Winnebago County:


7 DAY CASE RATE FOR PCR CONFIRMED + PROBABLE CASES



PERCENT POSITIVITY FOR WISCONSIN (PAST 7 DAYS)




