Spotlight: Immunization & Childhood Vaccines

- Wisconsinites aged 5-18 are tracking at 37% lower for routinely administered vaccines than they were pre-pandemic. More data can be found [on DHS](#).
- Follow the Catch-up schedule for [children](#) and [adults](#).
- The [Consistent, Confident, and Concise](#) Method of vaccine recommendation helps parents feel comfortable with vaccination.

Spotlight: Latent Tuberculosis Infection

- There is a medication shortage of Rifapentine and INH
- If you have a patient with LTBI who is a TB contact or is immunocompromised, consider an [alternative regimen](#) in order to ensure no treatment interruptions.
- If the patient is high risk and is unable to take an alternative regimen, please email the [Wisconsin TB Program](#), or call 608-261-6319.

Spotlight: COVID-19 & Influenza

- It is safe to get both a COVID-19 vaccine and a flu vaccine at the same visit ([CDC](#)).
- Everyone 5 years and older needs an updated ([bivalent](#)) booster dose to stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines.
- Individuals can get the updated booster at least 2 months after their last COVID-19 primary vaccine or original ([monovalent](#)) booster.
- COVID [Community Level](#): LOW (10/20)
- COVID [Transmission Level](#): HIGH (10/21)
