PENALTY RANGE

FORFEITURE: \$150 minimum to \$300 maximum

REVOCAION/DISQUALIFICATION: 6-9 months (No waiting period for occupational license).

REFUSAL: 1 year revocation, 30 day waiting period and AODA.

IGNITION INTERLOCK: Mandatory interlock for all alcohol concentration of .15 or more, or when there is a prior OWI conviction

FINE AMOUNT: \$350 minimum to \$1100 maximum

VWS: VWS may not be waived, reduced or forgiven [§973.045(1)]

JAIL: Not less than 5 days nor more than 6 months.

JAIL PROBATION & TREATMENT OPTION: 2 years probation, impose and stay guidelines.

REVOCAION/DISQUALIFICATION: 12 - 18 months. (Occupational wait = 45 days.)

REFUSAL: 2 year revocation, 90 day waiting period and AODA.

IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE: 12-18 months Wis. Stat. s. 343.301(1g)(a).

FINE AMOUNT: \$600 minimum to \$2000 maximum (**EXCEPTION:** Maximum increases with higher BAC, doubled tripled or quadrupled)

VWS: VWS may not be waived, reduced or forgiven [§973.045(1)]

JAIL : 45 days minimum and 365 day maximum.

JAIL PROBATION&TREATMENT OPTION. 2 years probation, impose and stay guidelines.

REVOCATION/DISQUALIFICATION: 24 - 36 months. (Occupational wait = 45 days)

REFUSAL: 3 year revocation, 120 day waiting period and AODA.

IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE: 12-31 months Wis. Stat. s. 343.301(1g)(a).

VWS: VWS may not be waived, reduced or forgiven [§973.045(1)]

JAIL: Not less than 10 days nor more than 12 months.

PROBATION AND TREATMENT OPTION. 2 years probation, impose and stay guidelines

REVOCAION/DISQUALIFICATION: 24-36 months.

IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE: 12 - 36 months Wis. Stat. s. 343.301(1g)(a)
