This is a Pfizer & Moderna clinic for all OASD families, staff and community members. Children age 6 months* and older can attend this clinic to receive their first dose, second dose or booster (if eligible).

Vaccine Details:

- Offering Pfizer and Moderna vaccines, boosters, and additional doses to those eligible. (All vaccine type subject to availability)
- Available to anyone ages 6 months* and older. (*Children under 18 must have a [signed consent form](#) and parent/guardian present.)

Second Dose Clinic: September 8, 3:30 - 5 p.m. at Oaklawn

Arrival Instructions:

- Doors open at 3:00 p.m.
- Park in parking lot; enter Door #2
- Bring completed consent form
