June 15 | 9AM, Parking lot assistance for Badger Girls.



AUXILIARY POST 70 PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE


The first thing is; we need everyone to get your renewal sent in to Dolores. We are guite far behind in the District, so please get them paid.


