## COVID-19 VACCINE AND UPDATED BOOSTERS AVAILABLE AT SUNNYVIEW EXPO CENTER

**OSHKOSH, WIS. (October 4, 2022)** – The updated COVID-19 bivalent booster along with primary series of the COVID-19 vaccine are now available on Wednesdays from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at Sunnyview Expo Center (500 E County Road Y, Oshkosh). The clinics do not require appointments and walk-ins are welcome.

The updated bivalent booster targets the original COVID-19 virus and the newest Omicron subvariants. Everyone aged 12 years and older is eligible to get the updated booster at least two months after completion of your primary vaccine series. Primary vaccine series are available to anyone aged 6 months and older.

"Starting your vaccination series and staying up to date on your vaccines is the best thing you can do to keep yourself and the community around you safe from severe illness due to COVID-19," stated Doug Gieryn, Winnebago County Health Department director/health officer. "We encourage everyone to get the updated booster as soon as they are eligible."

You can find both primary vaccine series and boosters at the following local clinics:

  - Every Thursday in October, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.
