You have to be given permissions to get a premium account. You can gain access to premium by bringing your ID to your regional clinic or there is the option of doing it over video call; you still need your ID. 1-877-327-0022

eauth.va.gov is where you can find the travel pay claim button. It's still difficult to navigate, but if you are persistent, you will gain access to the travel pay reimbursement feature. Otherwise, you can request a paper form from our office to mail into Zablocki.
