Recently started serving Winnebago County. They are actively finding ways to improve the life of veterans. They assist with Musky Fishing Trips, have a Veterans Thrive Garden, are involved with escorting Purple Heart Veterans to EAA every year, assist with gas and grocery cards for emergency assistance, and so much more. They also have a program called the Veterpreneur Project.

Veterepreneur Project is one of their programs that is a Small Business Accelerated Program. If you are a veteran who owns a small business or wants to own a business, this program is for you. This is a seven week course hosted by "The Venture Project," focused on instructing, consulting, and mentoring veterans with their small business. At the end of the course they do a pitch contest for a chance to win \$5000. They invite investors from around the community to provide an opportunity for additional funding.
