- PACT ACT SPECIAL HEALTH CARE ENROLLMENT PERIOD: Oct. 1, 2022- Oct. 1, 2023. This is
 important because it waives the five year eligibility window that was in place. So if you served in
 the Persian Gulf or in combat against hostile forces aft November 11,1998, you have ONE YEAR
 to get into VA Health Care without the VA looking at your income.
- VA Life Insurance (VALIFE) enrollment is opening up. S-DVI will not be accepting anymore applications after Dec. 31, 2022 as the VA is merging to the VALIFE.
- Marine Corps League is opening their doors to anyone who would like to watch Packer Night Games. Finger food is available, or bring a small dish if you would like too.
- Omro Post 234 is having Monday Night BINGO on the 3rd Monday of the month. There is FREE Parking!
- Recap from last month's meeting, Jeremy Otto from WDVA is looking for a locally owned veteran business that can do their story on. WDVA would put together a 3 minute video on the veteran and their product that they would share publicly. They would own the rights to the video, but the veteran could use it whenever he or she would like too.
