Not only do they provide assistance to the individual, but they provide Education and Mental Health First Aid Training to Family Members, Police Departments, and the Public, in order to help bring awareness to those involved.

Nami provides Family Support Groups the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month from 11:00-4:00. They also provide Peer Support Groups on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month.
