In addition to the primary vaccine series, receiving the updated bivalent booster reduces the risk of becoming seriously ill, being hospitalized, or dying from COVID-19. The updated bivalent booster targets the original virus that causes COVID-19 and the Omicron variants BA.4 and BA.5.
