Cory was previously an Intern for Winnebago CVSO, and is now the Operations Director and Veteran Outreach Coordinator at the Day By Day Warming Shelter. The Day By Day Warming Shelter is a 25 bed shelter and a last chance shelter. The new shelter will be a 50 bed facility with the capability of 72. It will also be a 365 day shelter.

Cory emphasized that they have a separate storage for specific donations for veterans and that there is also the opportunity to sponsor a veteran.
