# No-Till/Strip Till

No-Till/Strip Till limits the soil disturbance to manage the amount, orientation, and disruption of crop and plant residue on the soil surface year-round.

**\$22/ac.**

**Maximum 100 acres**

# Cover Crops



Cover Cropping is the practice of planting a crop after harvesting the cash crop to maintain soil cover and root growth before planting the next years crop.

**\$72/ac.**

**Maximum 100 acres**

# Add On Practices

Spring Interseeding - **\$15/ac.**

Planting Green - **\$15/ac.**

Adding Tillage Radish to Wheat - **\$5/ac.**

Frost Seeding Red Clover into Winter Wheat - **\$5/ac.**

Harvesting and/or Grazing Cover Crops on High Phosphorus Fields - **\$5/ac.**

Low-Disturbance Manure Application - **\$35/ac.**

**One year per practice per farmer. Maximum 50 acres per practice.**
