- ✓ ...provide current, accurate information regarding public benefit programs to persons who are 18 – 69 years of age.
- ✓ ...advocate, counsel and/or negotiate matters for you concerning eligibility for various programs and public benefits.
- ✓ ...help people apply for benefits or appeal a denial of benefits/
- ✓ ...refer you to appropriate agencies or sources to solve problems concerning public benefit programs.
