### DOWNTOWN OSHKOSH COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC CLOSED THIS FRIDAY

**OSHKOSH, Wis. (May 26, 2022)** – The Winnebago County Health Department's COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic, regularly held on Fridays at the County Administration Building in Oshkosh, will be closed on Friday, May 27. The clinic will be open again on Friday, June 3 from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the County Administration Building (112 Otter Avenue, Oshkosh). The clinic is available to anyone 5 years and older and offers Pfizer and Moderna vaccines and boosters to eligible individuals.
