Peanut Butter Christmas Cookies!

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup softened butter
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/3 cup peanut butter
- o 1 egg
- o 1/2 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 1 3/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- Wilton pearlized nonpareil Christmas sprinkles
- Peppermint Hershey's kisses (any kind work)

Instructions

- Preheat your oven to 350F.
- Line a baking sheet with a piece of parchment paper.
- In a large mixing bowl, beat your softened butter with your sugars.
- Now mix in peanut butter, egg, and vanilla.
- Then mix in your flour and baking soda.
- Mix in a few tablespoons of sprinkles and scoop out your dough with a tablespoon and roll it into a ball.
- Bake for 10 minutes.
- Let your cookies cool for about 5 minutes and then place an unwrapped Hershey's Kiss into the top of each cookie and let your cookies cool completely (if you place the kisses in too soon, they will melt).

Medicare Open Enrollment ends Dec 7th!

What can I do during Medicare open enrollment?

- Switch from Original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage Plan
- Switch from a Medicare Advantage Plan to Original Medicare
- Change Medicare Advantage plans
- Change Medicare Part D plans, sign up for Part D, or drop Part D
- There is another open enrollment only for people who are in Medicare Advantage plans. It runs January 1st through March 31st. People who are already enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan can switch to a different Advantage plan (with or without drug coverage), drop the Advantage plan and return to Original Medicare and enroll in a stand-alone Part D plan. During this January to March period a person can't enroll in an Advantage plan if all they have is Medicare nor can they switch drug plans.
- Need help or have questions? You can call our office to speak to one of our Elderly Benefit Specialists (age 60+) or Disability Benefit Specialists (ages 18-59).

Marketplace Open Enrollment ends Dec 15th!



Did you know that we have someone available to ask questions to about Marketplace health insurance? You may have also heard Marketplace referred to as the Affordable Care Act or Obamacare. Marketplace open enrollment ends Dec 15th. We have an employee, Mary Geffers who can assist you in applying for health insurance through the Marketplace.
