The EARN Project, a partnership between the Winnebago County District Attorney's office and Fox Valley Technical College, is a component of a diversion program created to give individuals an opportunity to pursue education and career development instead of incarceration. The course is designed as an intervention for examining the skills, habits, and attitude needed for personal growth and success. The EARN Project explores career pathways and increases student awareness of the many supports within continuing higher education.

The course has multiple entry points and can be completed in six months, which will enable student choice about next steps toward future possibilities.
