POLLING PLACES

State law allows that anyone may observe election night procedures after the polls are closed, but may not interfere with the orderly conduct of the election process. Exit polls are permitted by law, but must not interfere with the election or be done until the voters are through voting.

You are also welcome to observe election activities at any of the town, village or city offices.
