Oaklawn Elementary School

(112 Viola Ave. - Door #1)

Open to all OASD families with children age 5* and older. About 120 doses will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. (*Children under 18 must have a [signed consent form](#) and parent/guardian present.)

Vaccine Details:

- Pfizer (2-dose vaccination) available for ages 5 and up
- Follow-up clinic for second Pfizer dose is November 29 from 3:30 - 6:30 p.m. at Oaklawn

Arrival Instructions:

- Doors open at 3:30 p.m.; DO NOT arrive early as the school day is ending
- Park in either lot next to the school; enter via Door #1 by the flagpole or Door #2
- Bring completed consent form
