<u>CaptionCall</u> - The CaptionCall captioned telephone is designed to let you hear and read what the other person is saying, so you can better understand the conversation. The phone and service are exclusively for people with hearing loss who need captions to use the phone. CaptionCall is part of a federally funded program to benefit people with hearing loss. This fund pays the total cost of service for qualified users.

<u>DWD</u> - Veteran Employment Services - The Department of Workforce Development (DWD), is committed to advancing employment opportunities for Wisconsin veterans through targeted business engagement and service and commitment to the veteran community.
