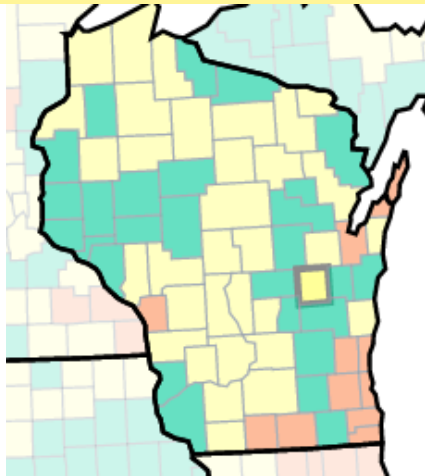
### Key Points:

- Our CDC community level is now **MEDIUM** due to an increase in total cases.\*
- Get tested if you are ill or suspect exposure.
- Vaccinate or get your booster if you are not up to date.
- If you are at high risk for severe illness or in contact with people who are high risk, take precautions.
- Please note that case data by school district, previously reported on page 5 of this report, will be on hiatus for the summer. Overall community conditions are indicated by the other data available in this report.

\*Community level is determined by CDC for all of Winnebago County. Other case counts in this report use the WCHD service area that does not include the portions of the City of Menasha and City of Appleton located in Winnebago County.

## Community Recommendations:

- Get vaccinated. Staying up to date on your COVID-19 vaccines is the best thing you can do, no matter the community level.

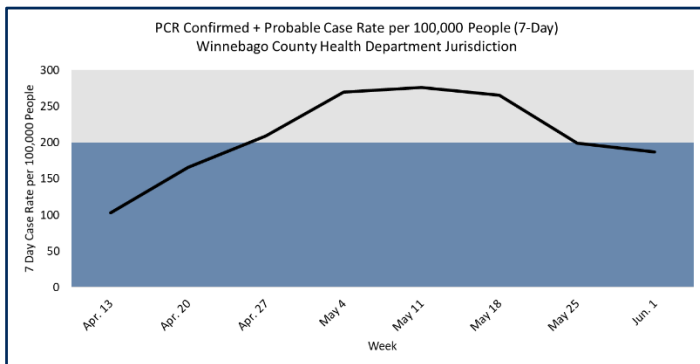
## Current Community Level Metrics for Winnebago County:

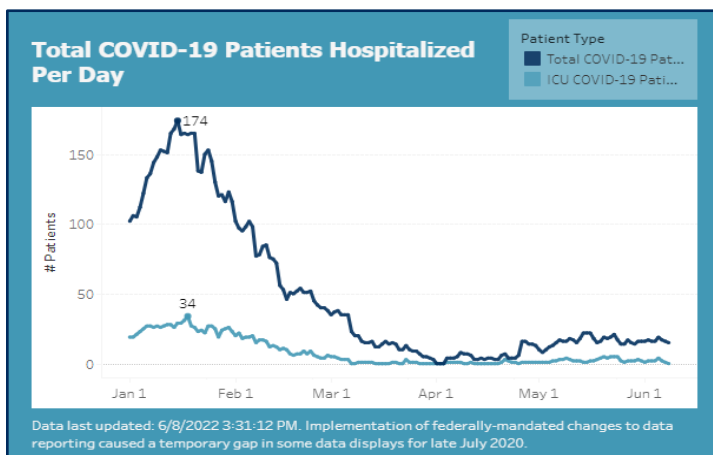

# HOSPITALIZATIONS IN FOX VALLEY HERC REGION



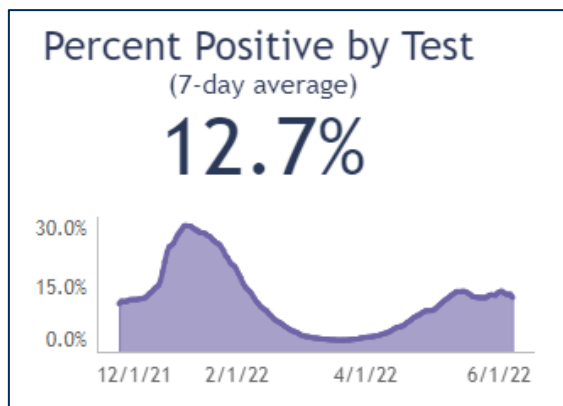

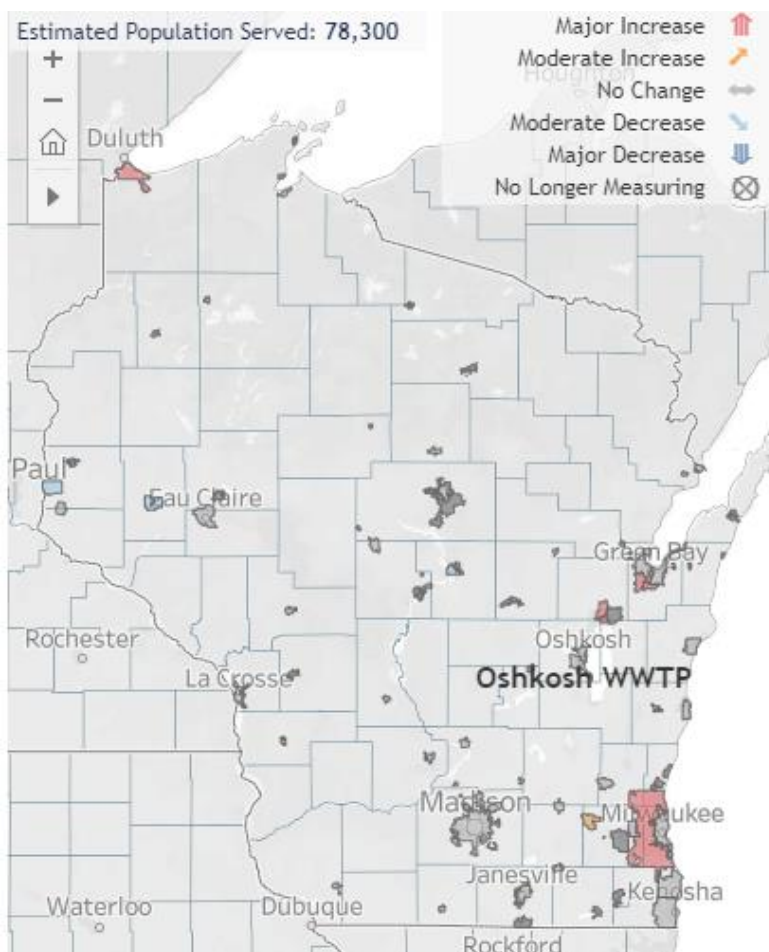

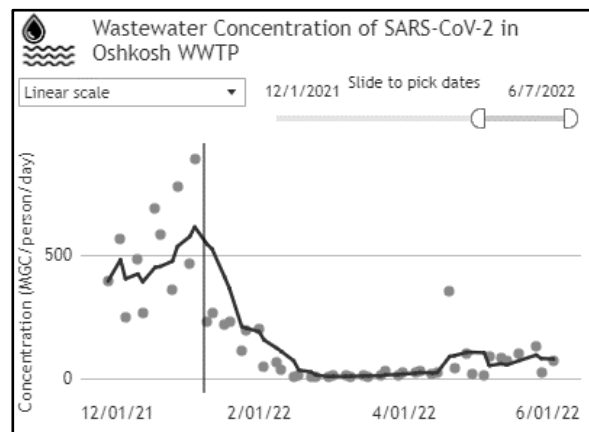

## WASTEWATER SURVEILLANCE DATA



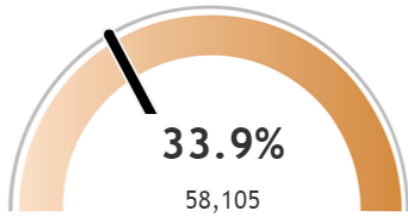
Concentration of SARS-CoV-2 in wastewater: 70.7 million gene copies per person per day as of 5/31.

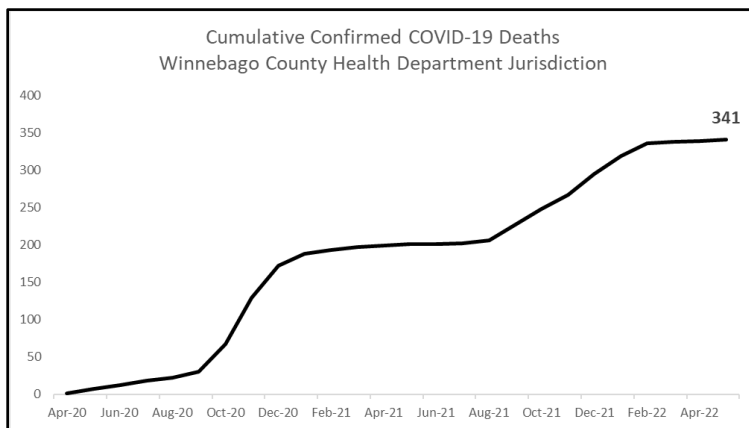
