SUBJECT: **WINNEBAGO COUNTY 2021 CONSERVATION POSTER CONTEST**

The Winnebago County Land Conservation Department is sponsoring a Conservation Poster Contest which offers an opportunity for young individuals to become interested in the conservation of our natural resources through artistic design.

Enclosed are the contest rules that includes some tips for making your poster as well as an entry form that must be completed, signed by a parent or guardian, and placed on the backside of each poster. **ALL POSTERS MUST BE TITLED "Healthy Forests, Healthy Communities" and must be on 14"x22" or 12"x18" sized poster paper.** The contest allows for only one entry per student. All entries will receive a participation certificate and the top three winners in each division will receive a prize and ribbon. The 1<sup>st</sup> place poster in each division will be retained and entered in the Area Contest to compete with eight neighboring counties at the Lake Winnebago Land and Water Conservation Association's meeting, Fri., January 22, 2021.
