# Marijuana Use and Winnebago County High School Students

### What is the problem?

- 33.6% of students reported using marijuana at least one time.
- 7.7% of students reported using marijuana for the first time before the age of 13.
- **20.9%** of students reported using marijuana during the past 30 days.
- **50.9%** of students reported that they strongly disapproved or disapproved of people smoking marijuana occasionally.
- **36.6%** of students reported that people their age would say it is okay to smoke marijuana occasionally.
- **54.6%** of students reported that they think people risk harming themselves (moderate or great risk) if they smoke marijuana occasionally.

K-12 skill-based health education
Evidence-based drug prevention programs
Trained staff
Parent and community education
Coordination of school and community-based efforts
Regular assessment of drug prevention efforts
