Memorial Bench Program

Cast iron benches are tough and built to stand the test of time, just like the memories of your loved one. All you have to do is pick a location and personalize a message.

Prices for memorial benches vary based on market conditions. Benches are built to the highest standards and can comfortably hold two to four people.

Building Materials: Cast iron & recycled plastic

Color: Heritage brown frame & redwood slats

Bench Plaque: No character limit for personalized messages. Logos, graphics or photos are not allowed.

Overall bench dimensions are 72"Wx31"Hx27"D

Maintenance of Memorial Trees & Benches

All trees and benches are installed and maintained by the Parks and Recreation Department staff or contactors.

Memorial trees and benches will remain in place for the duration of the tree or structure's lifespan. At the end of this period, the Parks and Recreation Department may at its own discretion replace or remove the tree or bench.

Winnebago County holds ultimate ownership over all memorial trees and benches and it is prohibited for applicants to decorate, personalize or add adornment to any tree or bench. Special maintenance requests for specific trees or benches will not be granted except in cases of safety concerns or damage. If a memorial tree or bench is vandalized or damaged by an act of nature, the Parks and Recreation Department will make every effort to repair the tree or bench within the limits of its available funding. If the tree or bench cannot be repaired or replaced, and if the tree or bench is a hazard or is unsightly, the Parks and Recreation Department may remove the tree or bench. Any memorial plaque, tree or bench installed without the approval of Winnebago County may be removed at the expense of the party who installed the unauthorized item. Winnebago County reserves the right to relocate the tree or bench for safety, environmental or land management reasons. In the event this occurs, the donor will be notified of the new location of the tree or bench.
