JOB DESCRIPTION: The Taxi Driver shall be customer driven, reliable, dependable, and detailed oriented. In this position the driver will be responsible for communications; for placing and receiving “fare” calls, communicating verbally to the dispatcher. The successful candidate for this position shall be customer driven and needs to be able to adjust to last minute changes and work with dispatchers for scheduled pick-up or delivery for new or established clients, when necessary.

Maintain contact with dispatch throughout the day. Collaborate with management to modify appointments to accommodate the needs of staffing. Cultivate strong relationships with the dispatchers and customers to reduce the stress that comes with last minute schedule changes.

Employees are expected to be **flexible** in this position, as a driver you may occasionally be asked to work hours in excess of the normal shift, and varying hours to fill the demands of the customer base.

DRIVERS ABILITIES: The Taxi Driver / CABulance Driver must have:

- Ability to apply common sense and understanding, to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form;
- Ability to deal with problems.
- Ability to recognize and respond to multiple and simultaneous events.
- Ability to analyze situations and to adopt quick, effective, reasonable courses of action to resolve such situations with minimal disruption to the general public;
- Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals;
- Ability to write clearly and concisely the routine daily fare-trip sheets, vehicle maintenance reports, gas receipts, and meter receipts.
