Development differs from child to child; however, there are some general milestones that you can expect like those listed below:

- Talk or understand what is being said (communication skills)
- Roll, crawl, sit, walk or reach for toys (motor skills)
- Eat, dress or help meet their own needs (self-help skills)
- Play with toys, problem-solve or follow simple directions (cognitive skills)
- Hear, see or interact with others (sensory development)

Early Intervention Services (EIS) can provide information, developmental screening, evaluation and access to services.
