

## **RESTRAINING ORDER - WEBSITE DIRECTIONS** (Attach to Harassment packet – *gray color*)

Parties filing a Restraining Order and having difficulty in determining what type of Restraining Order to file, are highly encouraged to work with an advocate from Christine Ann Domestic Abuse Services, Inc. If you are **not** filing your action electronically, after preparing your original paperwork, bring it to the Clerk of Courts office, 415 Jackson Street, Oshkosh WI –Room 110 (no additional copies are required). Be prepared to make payment of \$164.50 by cash, check or money order payable to “Clerk of Courts”. Visa/Mastercard are accepted, there is a 3% convenience fee charged to the card. There may be a wait in line before working with a clerk. Once you are with a clerk, the process can take up to two hours to process. It is best to arrive with your completed paperwork no later than 2:00 p.m. If you have questions before filing, please call (920) 236-1131.
