WALK-IN WEDNESDAY COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC CLOSED THIS WEEK TESTING AT SUNNYVIEW EXPO CENTER CLOSED ON THURSDAY AND FRIDAY

OSHKOSH, WIS. (November 23, 2021) – The Winnebago County Health Department's Walk-in Wednesday COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic, at Sunnyview Expo Center in Oshkosh, will be closed on Wednesday, November 24, in observance of the Thanksgiving holiday. The COVID-19 testing site at Sunnyview Expo Center will also be closed on Thursday and Friday this week.

The COVID-19 vaccine continues to be the best tool to protect against infection, serious illness, hospitalization and death from COVID-19. The vaccine is currently approved for anyone five and older, and boosters are recommended for everyone 18 and older at least six months after the second dose of Pfizer or Moderna and two months after a Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine. If you are feeling sick or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19, there are several ways to get tested for the virus. Contact your doctor or pharmacy to ask if they provide testing. If testing is not available, visit www.winnebagohealth.org to find a free community testing site. Free at-home collection kits are also available at www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/covid-19/collection.

Testing will resume at Sunnyview Expo Center on Monday, November 29. Walk-in Wednesday Vaccine Clinics will resume on Wednesday, December 1; the clinic is open to anyone five and older, and booster and additional doses will be available.
