We want to hear from you! We heard our residents' concerns about the need to improve community social connectedness and want to learn more from you.

The University of Wisconsin Oshkosh in partnership with the Winnebago County Public Health Department and re:TH!NK, Winnebago's Healthy Living Partnership, is completing a study to better understand the role of social connectedness and ways to improve relationship building opportunities for our Oshkosh residents.

If you have received this letter, your neighborhood has been selected to participate in this voluntary and confidential study.

We are asking our Oshkosh residents to complete a 5-10 minute survey to better understand our residents' quality, quantity, and accessibility of social relationships. Participating in this study will allow the Winnebago County Health Department and other key public health organizations to understand the role of social connectedness and guide future decisions to improve access/opportunities for social relationships in the city of Oshkosh.
