Tobacco Use and Winnebago County High School Students

What is the problem?

- 27.7% of students reported that they have tried cigarette smoking.
- 7.3% of students reported that they smoked a whole cigarette for the first time before age 13 years.
- 12.1% of students reported that they **smoked a cigarette during the past 30 days**.
- Among students who reported current cigarette use, 0.9% smoked more than 10 cigarettes per day on the days they smoked.
- 4.1% of students reported that they smoked a cigarette on school property during the past 30 days.
- **10.0%** of students reported that they **ever smoked cigarettes daily**, that is, at least one cigarette every day for 30 days.
- **8.7%** of students reported that they have **tried to quit smoking cigarettes** at least once over the last 12 months.
- 4.8% of students reported that they used chewing tobacco, snuff, or dip during the past 30 days.
- 8.3% of students reported that they smoked a cigar, cigarillo, or little cigar during the past 30 days.
- **21.0%** of students report **using an electronic vapor product** in the past 30 days.

What are the solutions?

K-12 skill-based health education
Ban all tobacco use 24/7 at all school functions
Evidence-based tobacco prevention programs
Access to cessation programs
Peer education programs and advocacy
Trained staff
Coordination of school and community-based efforts
