What are the issues?

• **10.0%** of students reported never or rarely wearing a seat belt when riding in a car driving by someone else.

20.4% of students reported having rode in a car or other vehicle driven by someone who had been drinking alcohol one or more times during the past 30 days before the survey.
8.4% of student reported having driven a car or other vehicle when they have been drinking alcohol during the past 30 days before the survey.
