# Updating Your Comprehensive Plan

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## What the law says

- Implementation element.
  - "The element shall include a process for updating the comprehensive plan. A comprehensive plan under this subsection shall be updated no less than once every 10 years."
    - Wis. Stat. § 66.1001(2)(i).

### Questions

- What is meant by an "update"?
  - Is an "update" the same as an "amendment"?
  - Is there a difference between making "major" changes to the plan versus a few "minor" changes?

#### Example:

### Dane County Comprehensive Plan

- See excerpt from the Implementation Element included as Attachment "A"
- Includes a process for amending and updating the plan
- Creates two processes:
  - Minor amendments
  - Periodic updates

#### Example:

### Dane County Comprehensive Plan

- Minor Amendments
  - typically consist of minor changes to the plan text or maps.
  - may be appropriate throughout the lifecycle of the plan, particularly if new issues emerge or trends change.
  - large-scale changes or significant shifts in policy should be deferred to the Periodic Update

#### Example:

#### Dane County Comprehensive Plan

- Periodic updates
  - Every five years:
    - solicit recommendations for amendments from the general public.
    - review annual reports.
    - evaluate progress in achieving plan goals/objectives.
    - review goals and objectives to ensure relevancy.
    - eliminate completed tasks and identify new approaches.
    - update timetables of actions, as needed.

#### Note

- The law does not mandate a total revision of the plan.
- Minor changes (amendments) might be all that is needed for an "update."

# Don't forget about the public participation plan

- It is required to address "every stage" of the comprehensive planning process including amendments/updates.
  - Wis. Stat. § 66.1001(4)(a).

# Amending/Updating Your Comprehensive Plan

- Follows the same process as for initial Plan adoption under Wis. Stat. §66.1001(4):
  - Plan commission adopts resolution recommending adoption.
  - Public hearing/30 days notice.
  - Governing body enacts an ordinance adopting the plan.
  - Copies of amendments/update sent to adjacent communities, DOA, etc.
