COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Registration Opens on March 12 at Noon **Free Vaccination Clinic at Sunnyview Expo Center Open to All Individuals Currently Eligible**

OSHKOSH, Wis., March 12, 2021 –The Winnebago County COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic will open registration Friday, March 12 at noon for clinics being held on Wednesday, March 17 from 9am-5pm and Thursday, March 18 from 2pm-6pm at Sunnyview Expo Center (500 E County Road Y, Oshkosh, WI).

Appointments are required. Registration will open to all currently eligible individuals. Please visit www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/covid-19/vaccine-about.htm to see if you are eligible. This will be a one-dose, Johnson and Johnson/Janssen vaccination clinic. You will not need to return for a second dose and will be considered fully vaccinated 14 days following your vaccination.
