COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC AT FOX CROSSING FIRE DEPARTMENT EVERY TUESDAY IN FEBRUARY

OSHKOSH, Wis. (January 31, 2022) – The Winnebago County Health Department will continue offering free COVID-19 vaccination clinics in Neenah at the Fox Crossing Fire Department (1326 Cold Spring Rd., Neenah, Wis.) each Tuesday in February. The clinics will be Tuesdays from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

"COVID-19 cases are still very high. Vaccination continues to play an important role in slowing the spread and preventing hospitalizations and deaths," said Doug Gieryn, director/health officer for the Winnebago County Health Department. "This clinic increases vaccine access to our more rural residents. We continue to encourage everyone to start their vaccination series and receive their booster when eligible, it's not too late to start and every dose increases your protection."

The clinics are open to anyone 5 years and older, and appointments are not required. Primary series and booster doses of all vaccine types will be offered. Additional doses of Moderna and Pfizer will also be available. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian present. Public health staff will be on-hand to answer any questions community members may have.

Free assistance is available to individuals in Winnebago, Outagamie and Calumet counties who need transportation or help navigating transportation options to their COVID-19 vaccination appointments.
