City Manager, Mark Rohloff, Volunteering at COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Media Invited with Pre-Registration to Visit the Free Vaccination Clinic at Sunnyview Expo Center Tomorrow

OSHKOSH, Wis., April 12, 2021 – Winnebago County Health Department has two clinics being held on Tuesday, April 13 and Thursday, April 15 from 8am to 3:45pm at Sunnyview Expo Center (500 E County Road Y, Oshkosh, WI).

Tomorrow, Tuesday, April 13th, Oshkosh's City Manager, Mark Rohloff, will be volunteering at the clinic. The media is invited to interview Rohloff between 8:30am-10:00am. Pre-Registration of media will be required. Contact Courtney Van Auken, Communications Specialist, to reserve your media pass.

About the Clinics:

Appointments are required. Registration is open to all individuals aged 18 and older. Both clinics will be administering the Moderna vaccine, which is a 2-dose series vaccination. Participants will need to return for a second dose on May 11th for the April 13th clinic and May 13th for the April 15th clinic. You will be considered fully vaccinated 14 days following the second dose of your vaccination.
